

*"The 340B Program enables covered entities to stretch scarce federal resources as far as possible, reaching more eligible patients and providing more comprehensive services. To participate in the 340B Program, eligible organizations/covered entities must register and be enrolled with the 340B program and comply with all 340B Program requirements. Once enrolled, covered entities are assigned a 340B identification number that vendors verify before allowing an organization to purchase 340B discounted drugs."**

How Can You Save Money With 340B?

Our pharmacies currently work with Missouri Delta Medical Center and SEMO Health Network to provide 340B services for patients seeing their 340B Program providers. Here's how we can help:

1. If you have a brand name prescription and the out of pocket cost is too high for you
2. Your prescription could be eligible for steep 340B discounts if written by a 340B provider
3. Our pharmacies work closely with two 340B entities and over twenty 340B providers

In 2019 our pharmacies saved patients almost \$100,000 out of pocket, and averaged \$75/patient/month in savings utilizing 340B (insulins, inhalers, blood thinners, etc. <\$30), our in house generic medication sliding scale pricing, and more!

If you have Medicare or private insurance, are your medications potentially 340B eligible?

*"The 340B Program does not prohibit covered entities from providing 340B drugs to individuals with private insurance as long as the individual is a qualifying patient of the covered entity and the drug is not subject to a duplicate discount under Medicaid." ***

Sounds Great? Now What Do You Do?

1. Contact one of our pharmacies and ask to speak with a Pharmacist or Community Health Worker about the 340B program
2. You will be asked to share your name, name of the high out of pocket cost medication, and who wrote your prescription
3. We will quickly tell you IF your prescription (or a comparable med) is 340B eligible, as well as the out of pocket 340B discounted cost to you
4. After speaking with our staff, if you are interested and *are not* seeing a 340B provider, our Community Health Workers can work with you to schedule an appointment, ensure you receive 340B discounts, and will follow up with you for subsequent 340B refills
5. Additionally, our Pharmacists can (if requested) follow up with your primary care provider to ensure they have updated records of your 340B discounted prescription history
